TASK GROUP 70.8.9 IS COMPOSED OF VARIOUS UNITS OF THE U.S. SEVENTH FLEET PROVIDING NAVAL GUNFIRE SUPPORT FOR THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH VIETNAM. SOPA AND OTC IS 70.8.9 EMBARKED IN USS MULLINIX (DD 944). THIS SHIP IS PRESENTLY AT STATION "RED" AT POINT ALLISON, MANEUVERING AT VARIOUS COURSES AND SPEEDS TO MAINTAIN STATION. 1A AND 1B BOILERS, 1A AND 1C GENERATORS ARE ON THE LINE MATERIAL CONDITION MODIFIED ZEBRA AND CONDITION OF READINESS II ARE SET.
